Curriculum and planning

During November our theme is – Winter

<u>Some of the activities offered in Pre School 2</u>	<u>What will we learn?</u>
Making Snowflake doilies.	Researching different weather climates and recreating them through art.
Getting ourselves dressed for winter.	Health and self care, learning to put our hats and gloves on independently.
Creating a winter display.	Using stamps, pictures and artwork to make a display, showing increasing control over our fine motor skills.
Ice play.	Exploring different processes i.e Freezing and melting.
Making Hot Chocolate.	Following simple instructions to make hot chocolate, making sure we do it safely.
Diwali.	Learning about Diwali through stories pictures and objects.

<u>Some of the activities offered in Pre School 1</u>	<u>What will we learn?</u>
Dressing up in winter clothes.	How to be independent by helping to dress ourselves with winter coats, hats and wellies.
Ice Play.	Finding out about how water freezes and melts.
Winter themed books.	Learning through stories engaging in imaginative thinking.
Creating snow flakes.	Using our creative skills to make and cut out shapes focusing on hand eye co ordination.

<u>Some of the activities offered in Nursery Room</u>	<u>What will we experience?</u>
Ice Painting	Creating marks using frozen paint to explore what sort of marks we can make.
Winter themed sensory tray	Learning through using our sense of touch, smell and taste.
Making snowflake pictures	Using a range of media to create our own snow flake pictures
Marshmallow snowmen	Developing our cooking skills, by using different types of food to create our own versions of snowmen.

<u>Some of the activities offered in Tots Room</u>	<u>What will we experience?</u>
Winter themed sensory play.	Developing our knowledge of textures through touch, smell and sound.
Dressing up warm for outside.	Helping to dress ourselves through putting willies and coats on.
Creating handprint snowflakes.	Creating pictures using our body parts and learning how we can make marks.

During December our theme is: Christmas

<u>Some of the activities offered in Pre School 2</u>	<u>What will we learn?</u>
Creating our own Christmas Cards and wrapping presents.	Exploring range of materials to wrap presents, talk about why we give Christmas cards and presents at Christmas.
Going for a winter walk.	To see what things we can find out and about during winter and to explore to outside environment.
Salt dough Christmas decorations.	Experimenting to create different textures.
Christmas Show.	To gain role-play skills based on the Christmas Story and to sing songs we have learnt about Christmas.

<u>Some of the activities offered in Pre School 1</u>	<u>What will we learn?</u>
Creating reindeer prints using our bodies.	Finding out how using our feet and handprints can make marks to look like reindeers.
Snow play.	We can use the snow for all sorts of fun things, in the small world area to create a winter wonderland or explore it in the sensory try to fill and empty containers to support our mathematical knowledge.
Decorating baubles.	To use art to create our own ideas and to be able to show pride in what we have achieved.
Christmas Cards.	Part of how we celebrate Christmas and to be caring by making our loved ones something special.

<u>Some of the activities offered in Nursery Room</u>	<u>What will we experience?</u>
Making Christmas biscuits	Extending our baking knowledge, helping to measure out and mix ingredients
Christmas Wreaths	Practicing cutting and sticking,
Reindeer Printing	Learning how make marks and distinguish between colours.
Christmas themed spice painting	Using our senses while making marks and pictures.

<u>Some of the activities offered in Tots Room</u>	<u>What will we experience</u>
Christmas themed sensory play	We will be learning how things feel and sound by exploring Christmas objects and materials.
Creating our own Christmas Cards	We will be expressing ourselves through creative design making cards for our mummies and daddies.
Reindeer Footprints	They will experience the feeling and textures whilst making marks with their feet.
Salt Dough Hand Prints	Making moulds of our hands for our mummies and daddies so we can see the changes as we grow.

Summative assessments

We are currently completing summary assessments for the children at Caerleon, in order to closely track the children's progress we have added the following key to the bands which link to the Early Years Foundation Stage

Codes

B=Beginning in this band

C= Consolidating skills in this band

S= Secure in this band

This means that we are able to track the children's progress from assessment to assessment
